

CONGRESS IN LONDON ENDS.

Prince Kropotkin Speaks at Farewell Reception to Delegates.

LONDON, June 2.—The Russian Social Democratic Congress finished its session to-day. The Congress passed a resolution condemning terrorism and in favor of the continuance of the Duma.

A farewell reception was given to the delegates to-night. It was attended by, among others, James Ramsey MacDonald, Secretary of the Independent Labor Party, and Prince Kropotkin, the Russian Socialist leader, who was surrounded by an admiring group of Revolutionists. The Prince and others made rousing speeches.

Several parties of delegates later started on their perilous journey home.
